These prints were made from photographs taken by Eadward J. Muybridge in 1877 and presented by him to Mrs Leland Stanford in 1870. The photographs given to Mrs Stanford were much enlarged, the panorama being sixteen feet long. It may be seen in the rare books room in the Stanford University Library. The dividing lines in the panorama given to Mrs Stanford are not as marked as those shown in these prints, each photograph fitting into its neighbor to perfection, showing how far ahead of his day was Mr. Muybridge in obtaining unusual and outstanding results with his camera. Historically the panorama is priceless, many of the old landmarks shown here having been destroyed in the fire of 1906. You will notice that the name of Muybridge who made these prints possible, is not mentioned, a fact that is most unjust and unfair and in line with much that has been written in connection with his great work.




